## Common myths associated with Occupational Road Risk

It only applies to companies with a large workforce



It only applies to company vehicles



A company cannot be liable if an employee has an accident in his own vehicle during working hours



A company carries no liability if an employee commits a Road Traffic offence in his own vehicle during working hours



It does not apply to the organisations in the Voluntary Sector



Occupational road risk never applies when an employee is travelling home in his own vehicle



It does not apply to the self-employed or contract staff



Employees who drive their own vehicles on business represent less risk to the company than company drivers
